The City of Tirupati

Tirupati is located at 13.65°N 79.42°E in the Chittoor District of South Indian State of Andhra Pradesh. It lies at the foot of Seshachalam Hills of Eastern Ghats which were formed during Precambrian era. One of its suburbs Tirumala, which is the home to Sri Venkateswara Temple, is also located within the hills.



Connectivity

The Railway station of the city is named as TIRUPATI and its station code is TPTY. Renigunta Airport is located 14 km east of Tirumala city. It is spread over an area of 312 acres. Direct flights are available from Delhi, Vizag, Hyderabad cities.

The Host University, Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati

The establishment of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University was the culmination of efforts during the period, 1955 to 2006 to strengthen education and services in the fields of Veterinary Science, Dairy Technology and Fishery Science in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

The University was created by bifurcating the faculty of Veterinary Science comprising of Veterinary Science, Fishery Science and Dairy Science from Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. The then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy inaugurated Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University on 15-7-05 at the valedictory function of Golden Jubilee celebrations of College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati. This flourishing University has within its short time of formation put in place a well defined administrative and planning machinery to build necessary infrastructure and man power, achieve financial stability and forge relationships to realize its goals.

The University has under its fold a total land area of 3042.92 acres spread over in its main campus, constituent colleges, research stations and polytechnics. At present there are 27 constituent institutions comprising of 3 well established Veterinary Colleges, 1 College of Fishery Science, 1 Dairy Technology College , 6 livestock research stations, 1 AICRP on Pigs, 1 Veterinary Polyclinic, 1 Krishi Vignan Kendra (KVK), 1 State Level Disease Diagnostics Laboratory (SLDL), 1 Centre for Continuing Veterinary Education (CCVE), 7 AH polytechnics, and 1 Fisheries Polytechnic .

University is about 3 kms from Tirupati (TPTY), 14 kms from Renigunta junction (RU) and 102 kms from Gudur (GDR) railway stations. It is about 25.6 km from Tirupati airport.
